


Whether you want to meet new friends with common interests, get help with household tasks, or just know that assistance of any kind is only one phone call away – Newton at Home delivers.

How You Can Become a Newton at Home Member

Membership is available to anyone living in a Newton household in which one individual is 60 years of age or older. Annual membership dues are \$725 for an individual living alone and \$850 for a household of two or more.

For seasonal travelers who spend a minimum of three consecutive months a year away from their Newton homes, our prorated **BreakAway Membership Plan** allows you to take advantage of all that NAH has to offer only when you are home to enjoy it.

Newton at Home also offers a limited number of reduced-fee memberships to residents with modest incomes.
